HIGHEST GRADE OF SCHOOL COMPLETED: None, Elementary school, High school, College, etc. Col. 16. CITIZENSHIP OF THE FOREIGN BORN: Naturalized, Having first papers, Alien, American citizen born abroad, etc. Col. 21. WAS THIS PERSON AT WORK? Col. 24. DID THIS PERSON HAVE A JOB? Col. 25 and 27. CLASS OF WORKER: Wage or salary worker in private work, Wage or salary worker in Government work, Employer, Working on own account, Unpaid family worker, etc. Col. 41. WAR OR MILITARY SERVICE: World War, Spanish-American War, Philippine Insurrection, Spanish-American War and World War, Regular establishment (Army, Navy, or Marine Corps) peace-time service only, Other war or expedition.
