A 203rd Regt. Penna. Vols., who volunteered Augt. 22nd, 1864 and dies March 21st, 1865 at Wilmington, N.C. That she was married to her said husband on Oct. 25, 1854, and had two children by him, viz.: Roland born Sept 5th, 1856 and Mary, April 12th, 1862, both of whom are living with her. That she filed her pension application No. 89-169 in April 1865 and pension certificate no. 77.262 was issued to her June 29th, 1866, commencing March 2nd/65 at \$8. per month, and subsequently had it increased for her two children. That some years ago she removed to Buffalo, N. York and then removed to South Manitou Island, Michigan, and drew her pension there up to about Sept 4th, 1874, by the attorney Wm. Bollinger of Milwaukee, Wis., who had her certificate and vouchers.
