To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Hendrik Fredriksen of Manitou County, Michigan

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Reed City, Michigan whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Hendrik Fredriksen

according to the provisions of the

Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for and the acts supplemental thereto, for the lot numbered two of section twenty-two, in township thirty-one north of range fourteen west of Michigan Meridian, in Michigan, containing sixty-eight acres

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Hendrik Fredriksen

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Hendrik Fredriksen

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Hendrik Fredriksen

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
