TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Homestead Certificate No. 5308.

Application 7013.

Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Reed City, Michigan, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Andrew Anderson, has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the lot numbered three, of section twenty, the south-west quarter, of the north-west quarter, and the west half, of the south-west quarter, of section twenty-one, and the lot numbered one, of section twenty-eight, in Township thirty-one north, of range fourteen, west of Michigan Meridian, in Michigan, containing one hundred and fifty-nine acres, and forty hundredths of an acre,

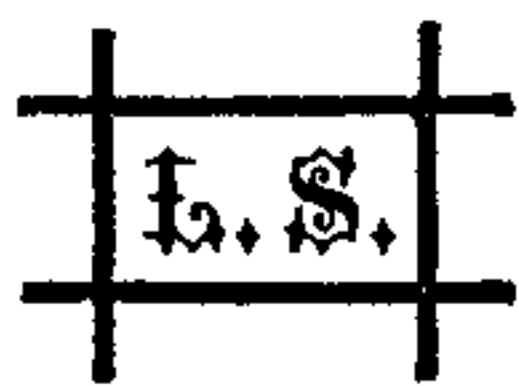
according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Andrew Anderson, the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Andrew Anderson, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Chester A. Arthur,

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the fifteenth day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and eighth.
