Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the

United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at

Reed City Michigan, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Mary Olson Swan, widow of Gustaf Olson Swan, deceased* has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the north east quarter of section twenty one, in township thirty one north of range fourteen west of Michigan Meridian in Michigan containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Mary Olson Swan the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Mary Olson Swan* and to her heirs and assigns forever.

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
