Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Grayling, Michigan, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Peter Hansen has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the East half of the North West quarter of Section Twenty-one in Township Thirty-one North of Range Fourteen West of Michigan Meridian in Michigan containing eighty acres.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Peter Hansen the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Peter Hansen and to his heirs and assigns forever.
