of the Register of the Land Office at Grayling, Michigan, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of John O. Andersen has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West half of the North West quarter and the West half of the South West quarter of Section twenty-two, in Township thirty-one North, of Range fourteen West of Michigan Meridian in Michigan, containing one hundred and sixty acres -

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said John O. Andersen the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John O. Andersen and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof I, Grover Cleveland President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
