To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Know Ye, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An Act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847.

Martilda Greenman, Widow and Thomas Greenman, child, and heirs at Law of Thomas Greenman, deceased, late a Private in the United States Army,

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *their* favor, numbered

79593, for 140 acres.

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Daniel A. Van Valkenburgh,* assignee of the *said* *Martilda Greenman,* and of *Phineas L. Ely,* duly appointed Guardian of the said *Thomas Greenman,* and to his heirs, the Lots numbered one of section Twenty, and the Lots numbered Three and Four of section Twenty one, in Township Thirty two, north, of Range Fourteen, West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Traverse City, Michigan, containing one hundred and fifty five acres and seventy hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND

TO HOLD the said *parts of said* sections of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

heirs and assigns forever.
