

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An
Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged
in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE,
Warrant No. 10/247 for 160 acres, in favor of Gregorio Briones
Warrant No. 101,247 for 160 acres, in favor of Gregorie Briones, Teamster, W.S. Quester Master's Department, Mor with Mexico,
with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North East quarter of election
five, in Township thirty North, of Range fifteen West,
in the District of lands subject to Sale at Fraverse bity,
five, in Township thirty North, of Range fifteen Mest, in the District of lands subject to Sale at Traverse bity, Michigan, containing one hundred and sayly acres,
according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the Catalana Lands by
the SURVEYOR GENERAL, the Societ warrant having been assigned by the said Gregorio Briones to Putnam Burdick in whose foror
Said tract has been located.
NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said
Julnam Burdick, as assigned as aforesaid, and to his heirs,
the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances
thereof, unto the said Sectnam Burdick, as assigned as aforesaid, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be become affixed.
