Whereas Peter Nemo of Manistowic^{ton} County Michigan

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Traverse City whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Peter Nemo according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the Fractional Section Eleven in Township Thirty North of Range Fifteen West in the district of lands subject to sale at Traverse City Michigan containing four Acres and Seventy hundredths of an Acre

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Peter Nemo

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Peter Nemo

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Peter Nemo

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
