To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. *2435* for *160* acres, in favor of *Cynthia Gilmore widow of George Gilmore Sergeant, Captain Smalls Company New York Militia War 1812,*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the East half of the South West quarter of Section five, and the East half of the North West quarter of Section Eight in Township thirty North, of Range fifteen West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Traverse City Michigan containing One hundred and sixty acres*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *The said warrant having been duly assigned to Edwin H Munger in whose favor said tract has been located,*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Edwin H Munger as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Edwin H Munger as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
